Dragon Hall is fully licensed for weddings and civil partnerships, making it the perfect all-in-one venue for both your ceremony and reception. We're also conveniently located within walking distance of many of Norwich's other extraordinary, licensed ceremony venues, including St. Peter Mancroft, Norwich Cathedral, Norwich Castle and The Flint Rooms, should you wish us to host just your reception and evening party.

GREAT HALL

A breathtakingly unique and romantic space to make your own.

Guests will be wowed by the high ceilings and crown post roof of the magnificent medieval Great Hall.


The Great Hall is the heart of Dragon Hall; a rare example of a medieval merchant's trading complex, built in about 1427 by a merchant, Robert Toppes. It was intended as a commercial building used to display, store and sell goods, and is unique in being the only trading hall in Northern Europe owned by one man. In the early 2000's it had a major refurbishment and was established as a venue for performances and events. It is licensed for civil ceremonies and was first used for a wedding reception in 2005.

In the Great Hall, history and beauty surrounds you. It is 26 metres long and 8 metres tall, and constructed with English oak from some 1,000 trees. The seven bays were originally decorated with colourful carvings — only one, a dragon, still exists today. There are large tudor windows overlooking the garden and river Wensum, letting in lots of natural light.

With its whitewashed walls, exposed brick gable end wall and exposed beams, the hall is a blank slate for you to decorate as you wish. We can accommodate a bar,

The Great Hall is the ideal setting for your ceremony, drinks reception and wedding breakfast. We can host 120 guests for your ceremony or reception, and up to 90 dining guests.

We only offer a limited number of dates for wedding bookings throughout the year. We usually host weddings on Fridays or Saturdays and offer a generous setup time of three hours the day before to make sure everything is absolutely perfect for your special day. We can also facilitate weekday weddings upon request.



OGEE ARCH ENTRANCE

As guests arrive at Dragon Hall, they will enter through the grand 14th century ogee arch doorway and into the Screens Passage. They can mingle in the glass Foyle Gallery or head up a short flight of stairs to the Old Barge Room; formerly the Old Barge Inn, a public house until 1969, it now provides the perfect spot for a bar.





FOYLE GALLERY

The downstairs Foyle Gallery is the perfect blend of historic and modern features: a bright glass gallery overlooking the garden and with an impressive brick arch as your backdrop. It is a versatile space, perfect for drinks, buffets and dancing.

Dragon Hall is licensed for music until 23:00. Due to the Grade I listing of the Great Hall, dancing must take place downstairs, in the Foyle Gallery.

GARDEN

Make a grand entrance to your special day by arriving by wedding car through the double gates and into Dragon Hall's beautiful courtyard garden. Bordered by a white flower bed, it is an elegant backdrop for photographs and a lovely spot for drinks and canapés, particularly in the evening sun.

We can offer a duo ceremony in the garden and Great Hall, with the ceremony taking place outside and the legal formalities inside.







Dragon Hall is fully licensed for weddings and civil partnerships, making it the perfect all-in-one wedding venue. We are also happy to host just your reception and evening party if you would like to hold your ceremony elsewhere.

A HISTORIC BUILDING, BRIMMING WITH STORIES



There are accessible toilets and the Great Hall is fitted with a hearing loop.





People have lived, worked and celebrated on the site of Dragon Hall for more than 1,000 years. There is evidence of Saxon dwellings built around 1000 AD in the undercroft and the Old Hall House was built in 1330.

The Great Hall is a rare example of a medieval merchant's trading complex, built in about 1430 by Robert Toppes. With its proximity to the River Wensum, Dragon Hall was the perfect location for Norfolk goods and imports from Europe and beyond including cloth and fine textiles, ironware, wines and spices to be stored and sold.

Over the centuries, Dragon Hall has been home to many families, and the middle section of the site was the rectory for the nearby churches of St Peter Parmentergate and St Julian. Walking around the site you'll spot many fascinating details, including the 50 or so witches marks in the Great Hall and Weston Hall which were painted, scratched or burnt into the fabric of the building to protect residents from evil spirits and demons.

A major period of restoration began in the 1980's and the site became a heritage and education attraction and a resource for the local community. In 2015 National Centre for Writing (then Writers' Centre Norwich) took over the lease of Dragon Hall, helping to secure its future and upkeep for years to come.

A CENTRE FOR STORYTELLING

Once a site for displaying, storing and selling Norfolk goods and imports from Europe, Dragon Hall is now an international centre for the trade of stories and words.

The National Centre for Writing uses the site on a year-round basis for events and workshops with writers, translators, young people, and communities. There are lots of opportunities for lovers of writing and reading from around the world to visit, as well as members of the public who wish to admire the history of the building or celebrate a special day within its walls. The old Brewer's Cottage located at the rear of the grounds has even been renovated into a two-bed house for writers and artists to use for residencies!

All funds raised through weddings, parties and conference hires at Dragon Hall feeds directly back into the National Centre for Writing's work and the upkeep of Dragon Hall.


